Moving out of the water to better understand freshwater functioning

Mariana Meerhoff is a professor at the Universidad de la República de Uruguay (e.g. https://www.researchgate.net/profile/Mariana-Meerhoff). She is a distinguished limnologist with a broad perspective, and authored or co-authored 85 peer-reviewed papers (Scopus h-index = 33). Among other things, Mariana worked on climate-change effects on lake ecosystems, global patterns of fish ecology and GHG emissions from inland waters. The current work of Mariana Meerhoff and her group in Uruguay focuses on the interactions between agricultural food production and climate change, and their potential effects on freshwaters. Mariana received multiple awards, such as the L'Oréal-UNESCO Award for Women in Science for her outstanding work. She experienced the common hurdles women in environmental sciences face and is heavily invested in increasing the diversity in this research field.
