About

In partnership with the College of Development Studies at Addis Ababa University and with the support of the German Federal Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF) the MigSoKo research group at the German Helmholtz Centre for Environmental Research – UFZ is organizing an international symposium on linkages between environmental change and human migration.

The symposium aims at bringing together leading academic scientists and research scholars to exchange their experiences and research results on the topic of environmental and climate change, natural resource use (conflicts) and human migration within the geographic context of Ethiopia. It also provides a premier interdisciplinary platform to present and discuss the most recent developments, trends, and concerns as well as practical challenges encountered and solutions adopted in the field of environment-migration linkages. The symposium will accommodate approximately 30 participants. The symposium language is English.

High quality research contributions describing original results of conceptual, empirical, or theoretical work on the above indicated topic are cordially invited for presentation at the symposium.
